

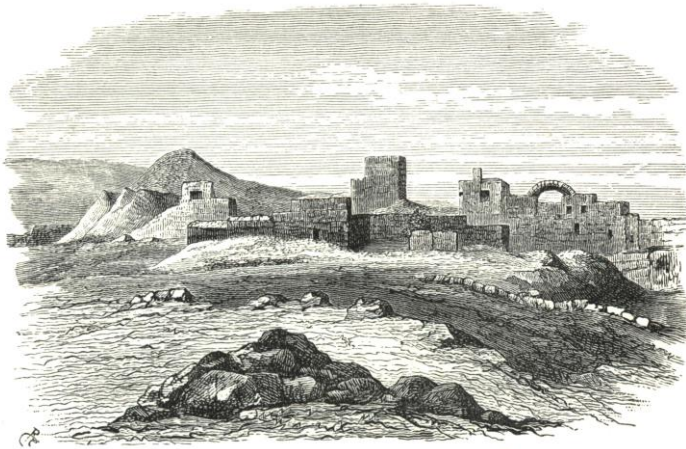

A select bibliography

The books included in this bibliography have been divided into three categories: history and religion, travel and fiction. The works in the first section demonstrate a keen interest among Nineteenth century writers in the history of Judaism and in the study of the Old Testament, while those in the second give an interesting insight into the geography of Israel, and the experiences of the people who traveled there. The section devoted to works of fiction includes novels of particular interest to the Manchester community, such as Maisie Mosco's *Almonds and Raisins* which is set in the area.

Students who wish to use works listed in this bibliography should ask a member of the library staff to retrieve the books required. Please make a note of the class mark, for example (Va 4), so that the books can be quickly located.

This is one of a series of booklists to be produced by the Portico Library on a variety of subjects ranging from the Lake District poets to books on the history and exploration of Australia, fiction on the North West of England, the Romantic era, Victorian lady travellers, and local history. They have been compiled with the help of the Manpower Services Commission Community Programme workers.

The Portico is a proprietary subscription library, founded in 1806. Most of its books were published in the nineteenth century and constitute an interesting and important holding.

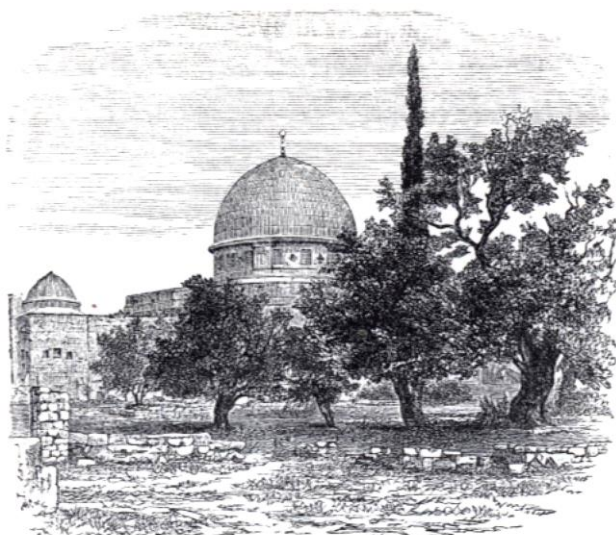
